

The Spectrum of Congenital Heart Diseases in Robinow Syndrome

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Abstract

We present the case of a newborn infant with classical signs of Robinow Syndrome and major congenital cardiac malformations consisting of double outlet right ventricle with subaortic VSD, infundibular and valvular stenosis, and patent ductus arteriosus. Similar patients of Robinow Syndrome with cardiac involvement are briefly reviewed from the literature and the importance of recognizing head defects in early life is stressed
